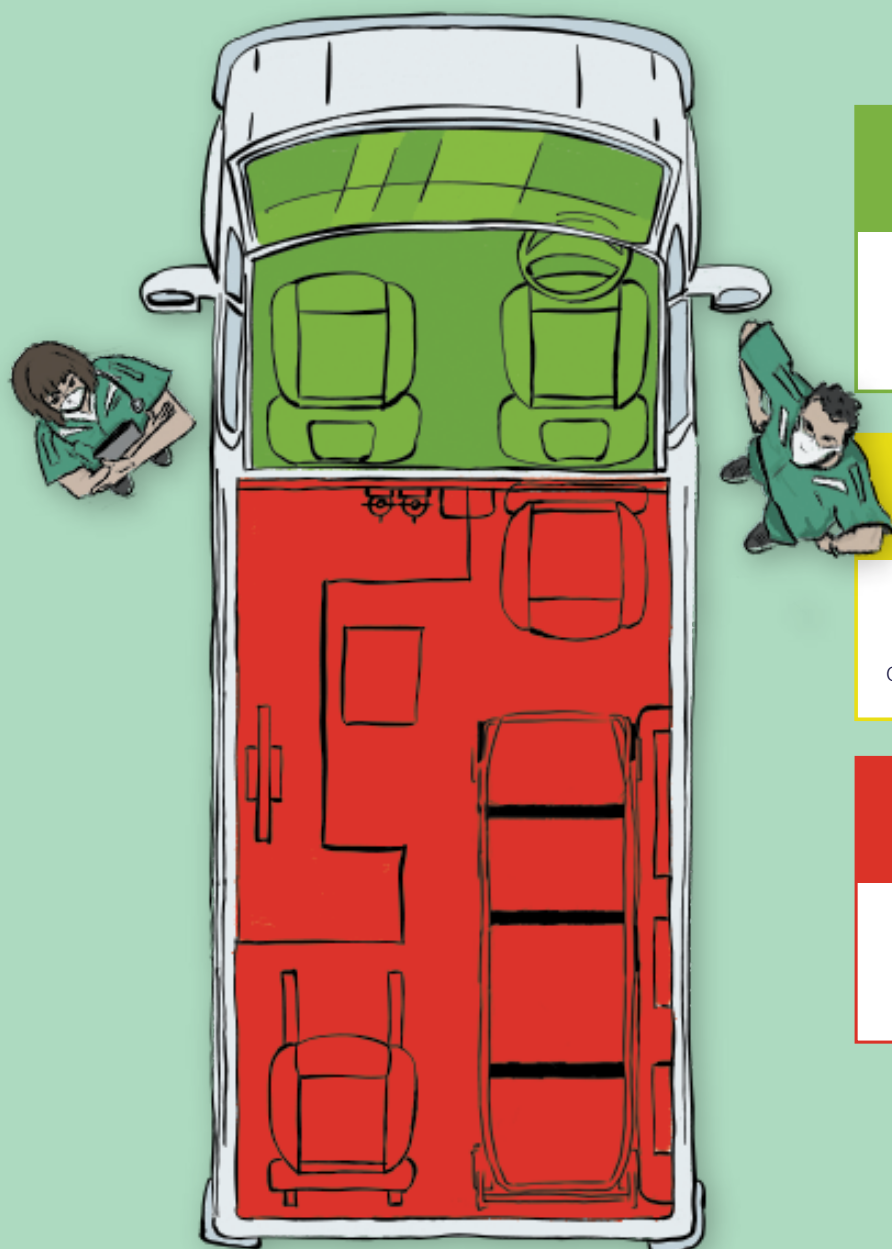


# HAND HYGIENE FOLLOWING HANDOVER

Once a patient has left the vehicle, the entire back area is now considered a Patient Zone (red) and you will require hand hygiene upon entering and departing. This includes prior to applying and doffing gloves when cleaning and post cleaning the vehicle. The front of the vehicle is still considered a Clean Healthcare Worker Zone (green) and hand hygiene prior to entering this area is still required. Follow these steps in order to prevent cross infection between patients and improve staff safety.



## CLEAN HEALTHCARE WORKER ZONE

Conduct hand hygiene before entering a Clean Healthcare Worker Zone.

## HEALTHCARE WORKER ZONE

Conduct hand hygiene before accessing clean equipment e.g. in overhead lockers and medication draws.

## PATIENT ZONE

Conduct hand hygiene before and immediately after leaving the Patient Zone.
